

# Competition Rules and Conditions of Entry

*(Please note the Buffet Crampon 190th Anniversary Clarinet Competition Section has additional extra conditions of entry)*

- All ages are at the closing date for entries, Monday 11 May 2015.
- Entrants will be required to provide their own accompanist. There will be no official accompanist.
- **Each competitor must supply a copy of the work(s) to be performed to the registration desk upon arrival.** Photocopies will not be returned.
- The decision of the adjudicator is final. Reports on each performance will be issued to each competitor at the completion of the Section.
- The adjudicator has the right to hear portions of each work, rather than the whole. **Time limits will be strictly adhered to.**
- Competitors may enter more than one solo section, but a different piece must be presented in each section.
- Competitors may not enter a solo section in which they have won first prize in a previous year. (This does not apply to Ensemble Sections)
- Competitors will be notified of the starting time of their section(s) in the week prior to the competition.
- First Prize winners may be invited to perform at the CLASAX concert on Friday 19 June.
- Competitors must perform live with the exception of the first round of the Buffet Crampon 190th Anniversary Clarinet Competition.
- Permission must be obtained from the organisers if pre-recorded music is to be used as an accompaniment.
- No prize will be awarded in a section if the adjudicator considers a suitable standard was not reached.
- CLASAX reserves the right to alter and/or combine Ensemble sections subject to the number of entrants.
- CLASAX reserves the right to award prizes in the form of vouchers rather than cash.

- Recordings do not need to be from a professional studio, although the Judging Panel does need high quality audio for fair judging to be possible.
- Recordings must be sent on a CD or USB device in audio or MP3 format along with the entry form and fees, postmarked by 18th May 2015 to the address on the entry form for this section.
- Each recording must be accompanied by an entry form and entry fee to be considered for the final.
- The entry fee covers both rounds of the competition. The entry fee is non-refundable if you do not proceed to the final round.
- Each recording will be taken on merit, with the names not known to the Preliminary Judging Panel.
- Up to 8 finalists, may be chosen for the Live Performance Round.
- Finalists will be notified by Monday 25th May via phone and email and must confirm their attendance via email for the final.
- Finalists names and final round works will be published on the CLASAX website and in social media.
- Finalists are required to provide their own accompanist. An accompanist list can be provided for finalists requiring this information please use the enquiries contact in the brochure.
- CLASAX takes no responsibility for the transport, accommodation or costs for finalists.
