Rosemary Smith studied clarinet under Catherine McCorkill at VCA then completed a Bachelor of Education at Deakin University. She has over 20 years of teaching experience with special interests in teaching primary school aged children and adults. Rosemary has enjoyed a varied playing career across a number of genres, from musical theatre to jazz and classical. More recently she's been concentrating on classical performance, completing her A.Mus.A and L.Mus.A, and performing with the Maroondah Symphony Orchestra and Grainger Wind Symphony. She is also an active chamber musician founding the Menuridae Trio.

Alex Campbell is a woodwind/piano teacher who teaches across both primary and secondary levels. She studied music at Monash University, majoring in clarinet, where she won the Anna Chmiel Memorial Prize for First Place in Woodwind and also complete her LMusA (with distinction). She is an active community player, playing regularly with Australian Youth Band, Grainger Wind Symphony & South Melbourne Symphony Orchestra. She plays for community/school-based theatre productions. and is also the Assistant Conductor for Australian Youth Band.
