Preparation for the Performance Competition

Entries have closed for the 2021 Performance Competition with many entries, particularly in the Backun Clarinet Tertiary Event and the CLASAX Saxophone Tertiary Event. The Buffet VCE Event is also well subscribed. The yearly Competition starts off with the Ensembles, large and small, at 5pm on Friday, July 30. These events are always quite a highlight with a very high standard achieved from the many performers. Starting at 9am Saturday, July 31 the individual events begin with a variety of events based on both age and AMEB performance level as well as Championship events in three age divisions.



Hand in a copy of the music to be played at the front desk. Numbering the bars is recommended. This copy will not be returned to you unless it is an original.Accompanists: It is best to contact your accompanist at least two weeks prior to the competition. You are strongly encouraged to arrange a rehearsal privately with the accompanist to adequately prepare for the competition.

You will have already been advised of your performance time. Check on your competitor number and the time of the event. Aim to be at the venue at least 20 minutes prior to that time. Hand the photocopy of the music to the person at the front desk and then head upstairs where there are practice rooms available to warm up. You will be asked to come into the performance room at the beginning of the event to listen to the other performers. Your family members are certainly invited to listen to you perform.



When it is your turn to play: Enjoy yourself, smile, tune up with the piano, adjust the music stand to suit you and then perform! Remember the audience probably won't know the piece you are playing; they are there to enjoy the music. Try your hardest to keep going and not make a face if you make a mistake. Bow at the end of your performance.

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At the end of the event listen to the comments from the adjudicator and pick up your own sheet of comments too.



Dress. Dress as if you were playing at the Opera House! Avoid tracksuits, sneakers, jeans and hoodies.

Parents are asked to pay \$5 to listen at the Competition and performers are free.



Winners are invited to perform at the CLASAX Mid-year Concert. Several of the people who won their event at the Competition will be invited to perform at the CLASAX Concert on Friday, August 6 at 7.30pm. This event will be held at

the Coatesville Uniting Church, Bentleigh East, 1050 North Road.
